(CHAPTER 333A)

TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS
(REGISTER AND PRACTISING CERTIFICATES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners Act, the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board, with the approval of the Minister for Health, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Register and Practising Certificates) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2012.

Amendment of Schedule

2. Item 3 in the Schedule to the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Register and Practising Certificates) Regulations (Rg 2) is amended —

- (a) by deleting “\$200” in paragraph (a) and substituting “\$225”;
- and
- (b) by deleting “\$250” in paragraph (b) and substituting “\$275”.
