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# Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics DECEMBER 2005

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## Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 599,755 in December 2005, increasing by 1,867 (+0.3%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$160,685,928 in December 2005 increasing by approximately \$6.1 million (+3.9%) over November 2005.

## Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,790,151 in December 2005, increasing by 12,913 (+0.7%) over November 2005. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$189,617,674 in December 2005, increasing approximately \$1.5 million (+0.8%) over the previous month.

## Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For December 2005, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 637,389 decreasing 3,329 (-0.5%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in December totaled \$310,675,762 decreasing approximately \$5.1 million (-1.6%) from November 2005.

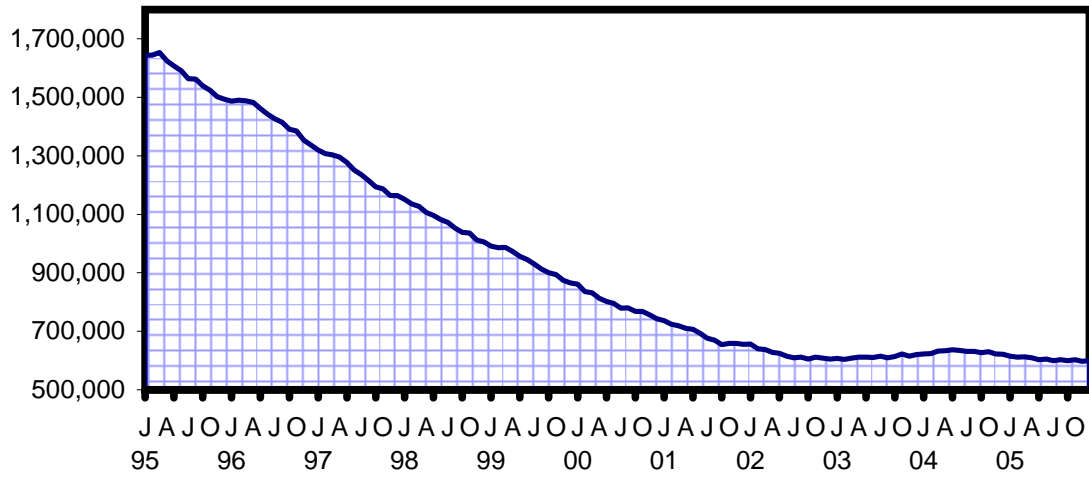
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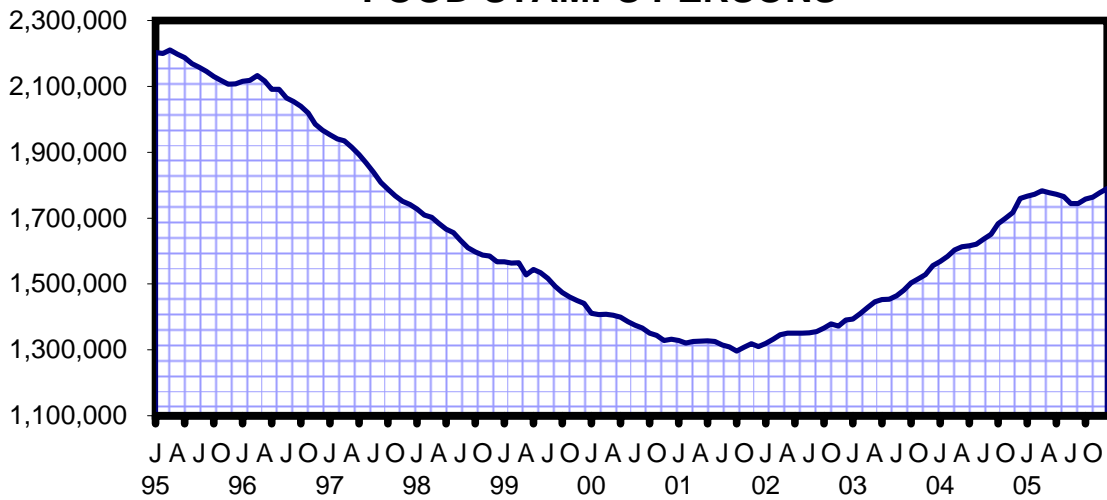

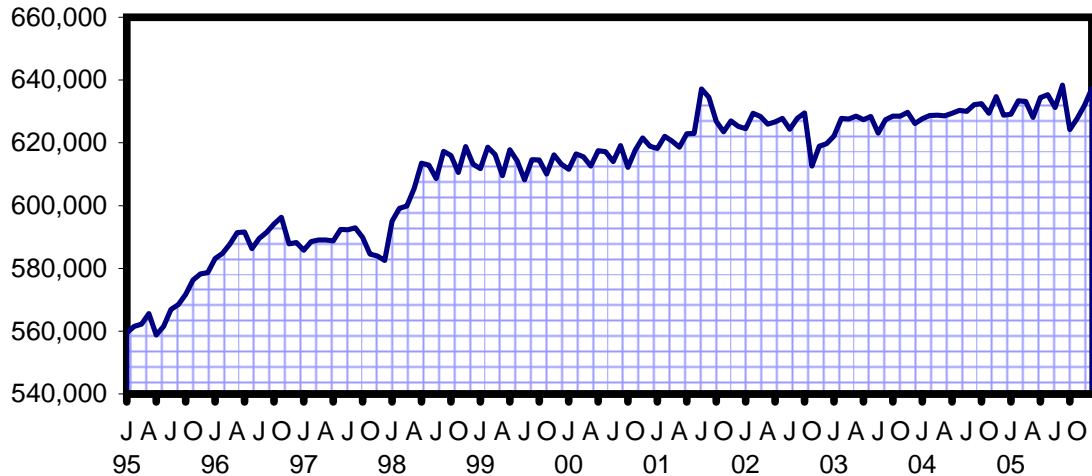
## TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS
