Meeting was called to order at 11:17 am by Deputy Director Megan White as nominee of the Executive Director.

Ms. White welcomed the appeals panel for the FY 2023 NYSCA grant cycle and reviewed the three specific grounds for appeal pursuant to Section 6401.2 of the New York State Rules and Regulations: (1) Non-presentation of information; (2) Misrepresentation of information; and (3) Improper procedure: (i) the review of the program request by the appropriate advisory panel was biased; or (ii) the program request decision of the council was arbitrary and capricious. Ms. White also explained the process set forth in Section 6401.2 regarding council and agency action on appeals panel decisions.

Ms. White led an introduction of the panelists and then requested that each appeal be presented to the meeting.
